

MAKE A SIMPLE ALTAR

1. Print. Cut out the 3 x 5 cards.
2. Fold card #3 along divider lines as shown in card #4.
3. Make an angled cut in card #3 as shown in #4.
4. Card #1 is a background for you to write, draw, or attached your own altar content upon.
5. Card #2 is an altar card from Day for Descendants Art & Altars 2022. It's an image of an abstract painting from Pario's Denial Series, combined with some thoughts. This is just one idea of countless things that you can do with a portable altar of this format.
6. Use this format or invent your own. Your altar can be anything meaningful to you. It can change, maybe daily.
7. Take a picture of what you do, post to social media and use the hashtag #DayforDecendants and @DescendantAltars.
8. Of course, you can make a digital altar! Please post those too. Place it on your phone home screen or background.

2. It can be this simple. Or a full altar, artwork, performance, writing ... whatever.
3. Dollar store tealights = bougie effect.

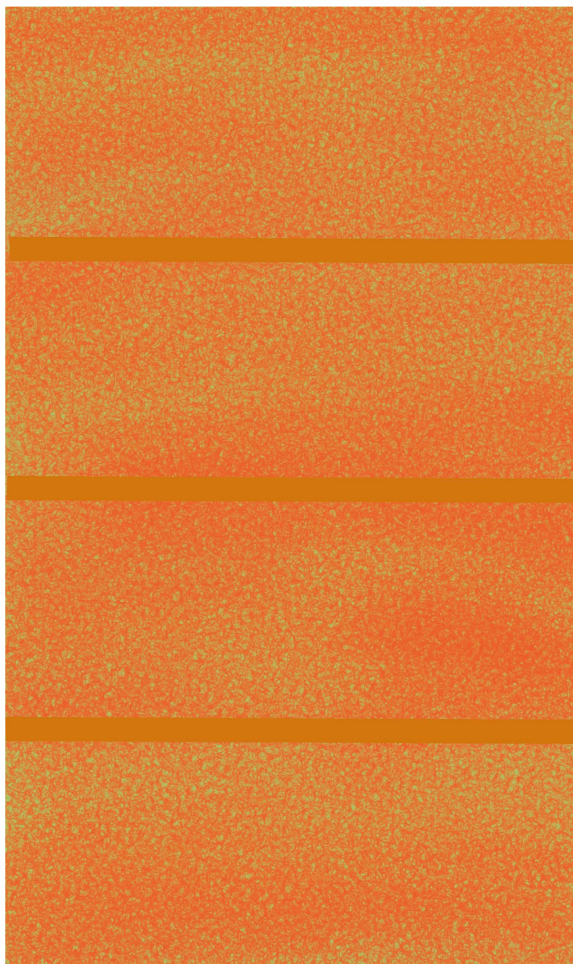
